

Importance of Case Hardening



If a caster fails, that means downtime for customers. The strength of the caster rig is vitally important and should not be taken lightly. At RWM, we strive to fulfill our mantra of Engineered to Outperform. The picture above is an RWM Kingpinless raceway that has been case hardened. You can see the darker grey outline on the edge of the steel. This offers enhanced long-term durability when compared to through hardened raceways. Heat treatment, whether case hardening or through hardening, is substantially better than the non-hardened products being marketed to lower up front (not long term) cost. It is important to know the differences of heat treatment methods and how they affect the lifespan of a caster. We recently put out a white paper discussing this topic and it can be viewed here:
